PLAYER MEASURING PROCEDURES

Rev 12/13/00

1. Each player participating in the State Tournament will be measured prior to his first game in the tournament. This will apply to every player in the Tournament, regardless of the number of years that the player has participated in the TAAF Six Feet and Under Basketball State Tournament in the past.
2. Any player who measures more than seventy-two (72) inches will not be allowed to participate in the Tournament, regardless of the number of years that the player has participated in the TAAF Six Feet and Under Basketball State Tournament in the past.
3. Each player will be measured per the following guidelines:
 - A) In the designated area, the player will stand with his back to the wall.
 - B) Heels together; heels against the wall.
 - C) Knees locked.
 - D) Buttocks against the wall.
 - E) Both shoulder blades against the wall.
 - F) Head erect and against the wall.
4. Players will be measured by designated State Tournament staff.
5. If the player's height exceeds 72 inches, he will be declared ineligible to participate.
6. The player may appeal the ruling of the State Tournament staff to the TAAF Men's Six Feet and Under Basketball State Commissioner, or his designated on-site representative.
7. In the case of an appeal, the State Commissioner, or his representative, shall re-measure the player as per the above guidelines. The player will be measured **once** by the State Commissioner or representative and this person shall render a ruling at that time.
8. The ruling of the State Commissioner, or the representative, is **final**. No appeals of this ruling will be considered.
9. Throughout the State Tournament, protest(s) of an opposing player's height by other Team Managers and/or players will not be considered.
